











Clean Water Act of 1972

- Focus on Point Sources
- Established N/SPDES Permit Program
- Came with \$\$\$ for GRANTS
 (\$60 Billion thru 1970s, 80s)
 and
- Silent on (or Exempted) NonPoint Sources



Water Quality Trends






Clean Water Act of 1987

- Recognized NonPoint Sources
- Some NPS (Stormwater) Controls
- But Not All (Agriculture Still Exempted)
- Emphasis on BMPs, Watershed Plans
- No Similar \$\$\$ for NonPoint
- Replaced Grants with Revolving Loans

From 1972 thru 1992, WQ Improvement Outpaced WQ Declines




Since 1992, Not So Much






Urban Stormwater Runoff






Dear Members of City Council, Citizens of Memphis,




